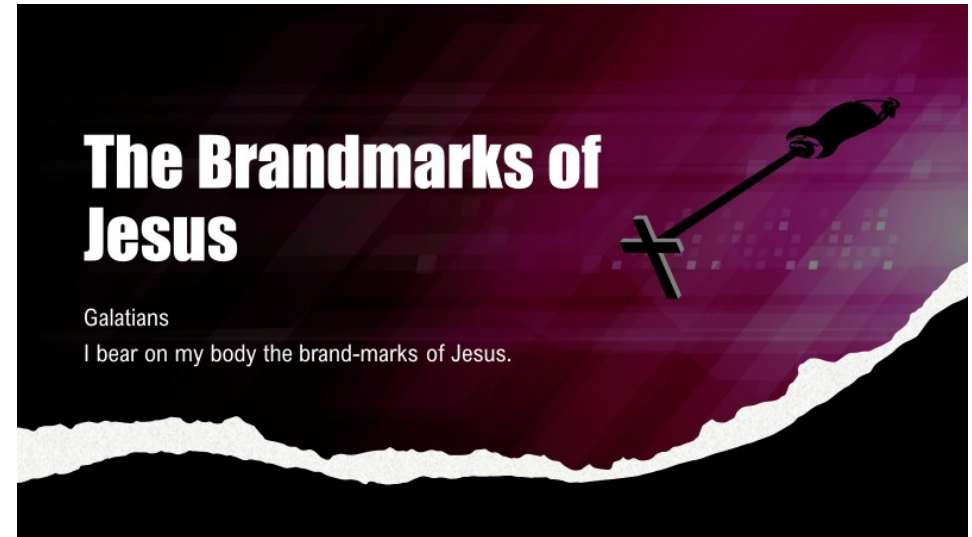


“THE PERVERSION OF THE GOSPEL” SERMON NOTES

- True brand-marks of Jesus give us confidence and peace when we are fully committed to His Gospel.
- Deserting: Don’t exchange Jesus for anything else—stay faithful to the One who called you by grace.
- Different: There is only one true Gospel; don’t be fooled by messages that sound right but aren’t.
- Disturbing: Don’t let side issues or troublemakers pull you away from the Gospel’s mission.
- Distort: Reject any teaching—human or angelic—that twists the Gospel of Christ.

Conclusion: Live to please God, not people, by holding fast to the one and only Gospel.
