# **DID YOU KNOW?**

Small Groups are essential to the church's strategy for discipleship, evangelism, fellowship, and ministry. Statistics continue to show that churches grow through small groups, not large worship services. Group discussion about God's Word helps participants understand, own, and live out the truth. A professor of mine told me many years ago that Sunday School is where the work is done and the worship service is where we celebrate what happened. Here at OBC, our small group ministry is the Sunday School.

Sunday School study time, intentional activities, and caring ministry builds strong relationships. Dr. Thom Rainer, while at LifeWay Christian Resources, discovered that when someone joins the church, 83% of those involved in small groups were connected to the church five years later while only 16% of those not involved in small groups continued to be connected.

Sunday School is very effective in evangelism. Many churches have discovered that 50-100% of lost persons who get active in Sunday School accept Jesus within 12 months. God use caring outreach, can relationships, and discussion about His Word to change lives! We hope to make steps to improve our Sunday School here at OBC. Pray that God will use our program to see many come to Christ.

The Preschool Ministry Team is responsible for administration of all preschool ministries and activities from birth through kindergarten preschoolers.

#### Senior Adult Ministry Team

The Senior Adult Ministry Team is responsible for administration of all senior adult ministries and activities.

#### Stewardship Team

The Stewardship Team is responsible for budget development, and budget administration along with stewardship development.

The Youth Ministry Team is responsible for administration of all youth ministries and activities for all youth in the sixth through twelfth grades.

Since February is usually a month we think about love, I wanted to highlight a hymn that most people learn at a very early age – "Jesus Loves Me." The lyrics were written first by Anna Warner to be used in the context of a book written by her sister, Susan Warner, in 1860. The words were to be used to comfort a child. In 1862, William Bradbury added the chorus and the music to the lyrics.

The sisters lost their mother when they were young and their father was a prominent New York lawyer and investor and lost most of his wealth in a financial crisis in the United States. They left New York and moved to a farmhouse in West Point near the U.S. Military Academy. In later years, the sisters held regular Bible studies for the cadets. "Jesus Loves Me" became a very popular song and the cadets told them that it brought great comfort to them and they would often sing it on the battlefields during the American Civil War.

May we remember and sing it as well, to be reminded of the unconditional love of Jesus for all!
