NOW THAT FAITH HAS COME

Galatians 3: 23-29

- Paul says “before **faith** came,” not “before Christ came”
- “Came” means **revealed or brought into being**
- Faith marks a clear change in our spiritual condition
- Before faith:
 - We were **kept in custody** under the Law
 - The Law guarded and confined, like a jailer
 - Dependence on the Law kept us from justifying faith
 - The Law served as a **tutor**, guiding us toward Christ
- The tutor was temporary, meant to lead us until faith arrived
- Now that faith has come:
 - We are **no longer under a tutor**
 - We are **sons of God through faith in Christ**
 - We are **baptized into Christ**, not into a system
 - We are **clothed with Christ** in every area of life
- In Christ:
 - No division by ethnicity, status, or gender
 - All believers are **one in Christ Jesus**
- Belonging to Christ makes us:
 - **Abraham’s descendants**
 - **Heirs according to promise**
